

<p style="text-align: center;">CHECKLIST: VISITOR - EXTENSION (3 MONTHS)</p>

Immigration Act: Section 11(1), Regulation 9

The visitor's visa can be extended for another three months, provided that such application is handed in at least 60 days before the existing visa expires. The extension can only be done once and by submitting the following supporting documentation:

- Application form DHA-1739*.
- Original passport with a valid entry stamp. At least 2 empty pages need to be in available and the expiry period of the passport must surpass the requested extension by at least 30 days.
- Proof of financial resources (bank statement over the last three months, salary slip, credit cards, traveler's cheques etc.).
- Reason for the extended stay (travel documents, plans etc.)
- Application fee of R 1775-00 per Person.
- A valid return travel ticket.

The application is done online via the VFS website, the fees are payable beforehand and the appointment needs to be booked online. All applicants have to appear in person and you cannot send a delegate. We will prepare the application for you, book the appointment and accompany you to the visa centre.

Should you miss the 60-day extension period and they are no valid reasons (sickness, accident etc.), you will have to leave South Africa and no extension is granted.

All documents need to be translated into English and only originals or certified copies are accepted.
